

ANNUAL REPORT

Academic section

I would like to start with academic section as academics is considered the most important part of child's education. I would like to share the results of Board classes i.e. 10 and 12, 2018 – 19.

- a) Talking about class 10th ...total 106 students from our school appeared for class 10th board in the last academic year.I feel proud to announce that we have given 100% result.
- b) In addition, 25 students out of 106 students got 90% and above 90%. Zumi Seth topped in 10 boards with 95.8% with 100 marks in SST &NandanTahcker – 100 marks in Science.
- c) Further 91 students out of 106 students secured first class that is 60% and above. Total 45 students secured about 90 marks & above in various subjects.
- a) I feel proud and happy to announce that in science stream we haveproduced 100% result, topped by Ayusha Chaudhary with 93%. 15 students secured 90 or above marks in individual subjects.
- b) Moving on to class 12 now- 88 of our students appeared for class 12 science & commerce in 2018-2019.
- c) In XII commerce we have 98.13% result with Nandini Patel securing highest of 86%. Five students secured 90 and above among all who appeared for 12 board and 60 students out of 88 students secured first class or above it. 8 students secured 90 marks or above in individual subjects.

Guidance counseling and teachers training

Workshop, guest lectures and Seminars for students

To bridge the gap between theoretical and practical aspects the school regularly arranges guest lectures and seminars for students as well.

4. Prof. Ravi Vaishnav and Prof. Prakash Siju- from Virayatan institute to guide the students of std. XII Science about pharmacy.
5. Ms. VidhiVora and Ms. PoojaKeshwani in collaboration with the rotary club motivated our students for the noble cause under the project called 'first cry', under which our higher secondary students collected excess food from the town and distributed to the poor and needy people.
6. Training for disaster management and civil defense
A 5 day training program was organized by government of gujarat for disaster management and civil defense.
